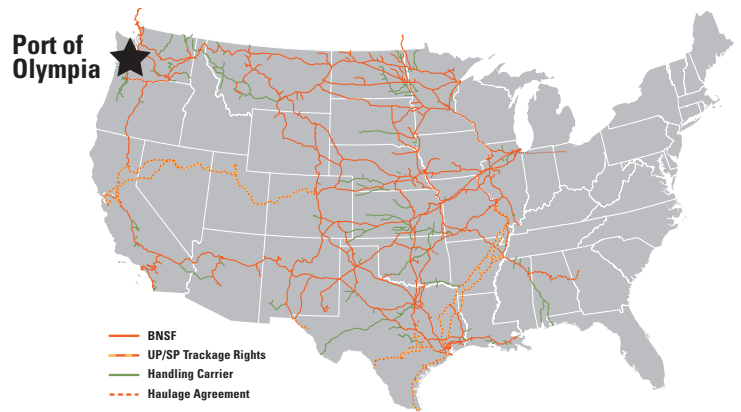


Port of Olympia

The Port of Olympia leverages special handling expertise and customized shipping services, at its own 66-acre terminal situated on the Budd Inlet at the head of Puget Sound, two miles from Interstate 5. The port is centrally located in Puget Sound within the Columbia River Basin region and provides ready access to local, regional, and international markets.

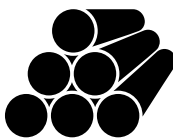
